Dear Board:

As currently drafted, SCAG's regional transportation plan projects an additional 200 households by 2045 in the City of Yorba Linda, but the RHNA projects over 2,400 new housing units by 2029, which does not comply with state housing law. Furthermore, when SCAG assigned the City its 2,400 additional housing units, it did not take into account numerous constraints that exist in the City, including wildfires, protected open space, flood hazards, and numerous other local land-use constraints. SCAG's proposed housing plan is dramatically inconsistent with its adopted transportation plan; therefore, the housing plan needs to be revised to require the City of Yorba Linda to provide for no more than 200 additional housing units.

As homeowners we ask that you take into account our current city and these very items that drew us to live here.
