Since the housing units were built, I have noticed an increase in traffic, and people who live in both complexes are parking their cars in neighboring streets and directly impacting the surrounding residents' quality of life. I am concerned that based on the current assessment of 2,411 units, the City's pride in high standards of living will forever be negatively impacted.
